

Castrol Two Stroke Oil

Product Safety Recall

Castrol is recalling some of its two-stroke (2T) oils as a Safety precaution; it is believed that some batches of oil have been contaminated with water and may cause engine seizure if used.

It is essential that the batch number of any Castrol two-stroke oil that has been purchased since the 3rd September 2013 is checked and, if found to be within the batch number range listed on the recall notice, returned to the supplier.
